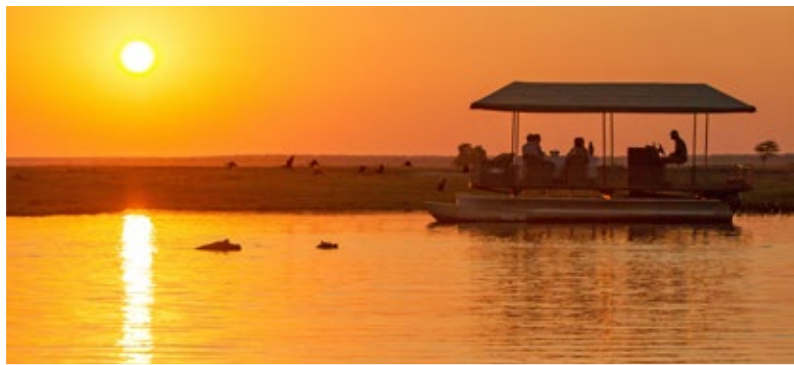

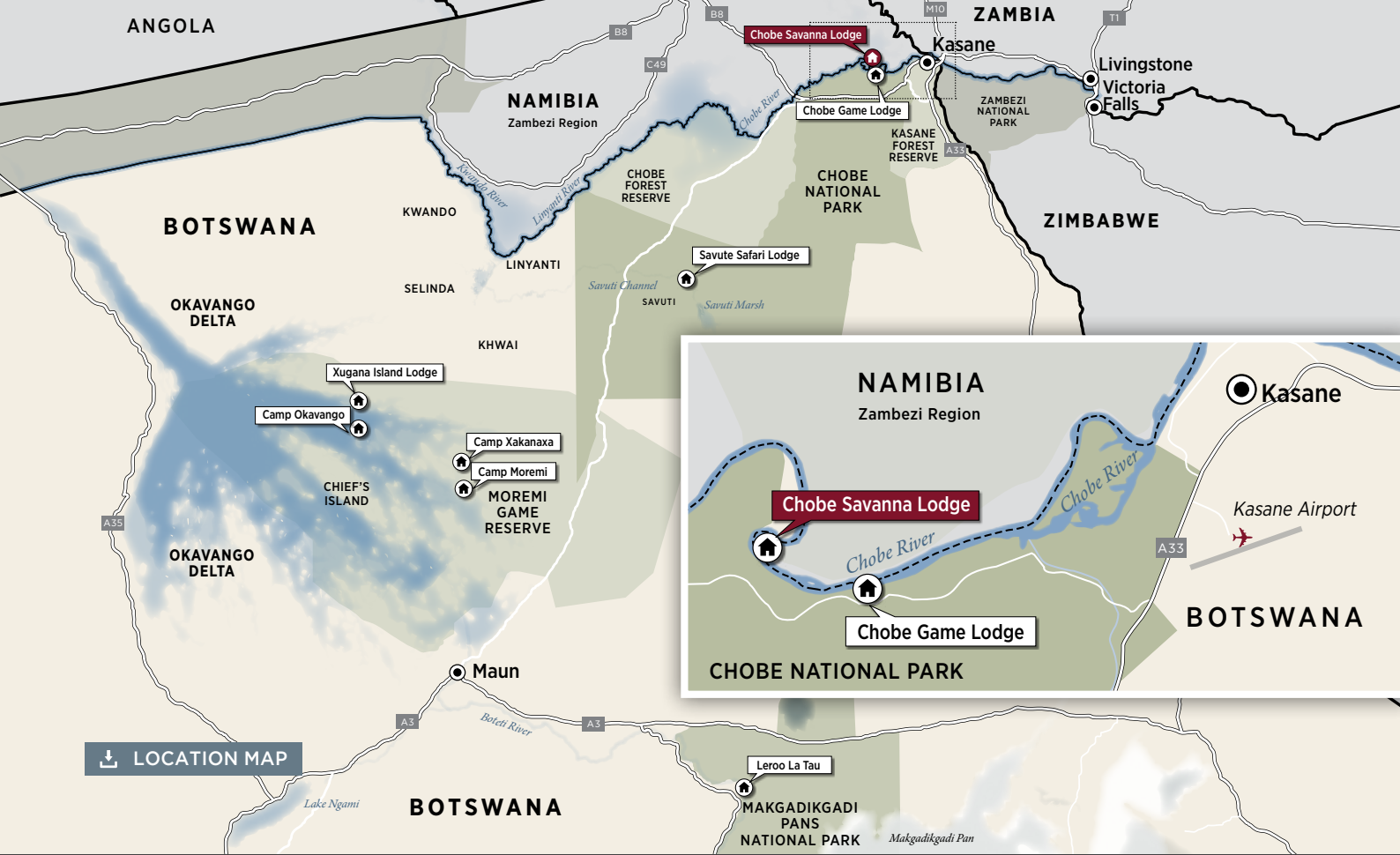

Situated in the Eastern Zambezi region of Namibia, a narrow strip of country on the northern bank of the Chobe River, Chobe Savanna Lodge overlooks the vast floodplains of the Chobe National Park's Puku Flats.

ROOMS	10 Twin bedded chalets, 2 sets of inter leading rooms (family friendly) & 1 Family room accommodating a maximum of 26 guests.
PILOT/GUIDE	N/A
RATES	Fully inclusive of all meals, scheduled safari activities, local drinks (including alcoholic drinks, excluding premium brands), park/admin fees and a complimentary minibar fridge in each chalet.
DINING	Various indoor and outdoor dining locations.
CAMP FIRE	Located just in front of the main area of the lodge.
SWIMMING POOL	Located in the gardens in the middle of the island.
VIEWING DECK	Superb view of the Chobe River and surrounding floodplains of the island, overlooking the Chobe National Park.
BAR	Fully stocked bar.
CURIO SHOP	Accepts cash and credit card payments.
LAUNDRY	Daily, inclusive laundry service available.
WATER	Reverse osmosis water treatment plant supplies drinking water (bottled water on request).
ELECTRICITY	Is supplied via Botswana's national grid, and AC 220V mains power is available 24 hours a day. The standby generator automatically switches on whenever a power failure occurs.
INTERNET	Wi-Fi available.
TELEPHONE	Telephone calls can be made using mobile phones or whatsapp.

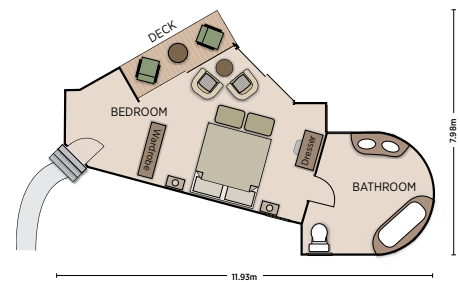


ACCOMMODATION

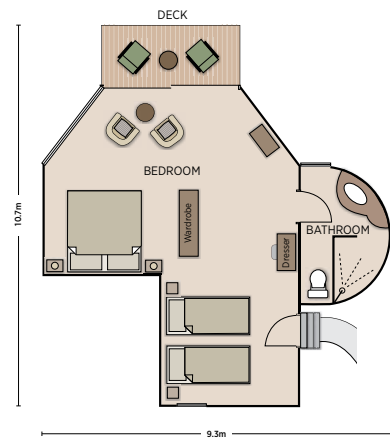
STANDARD ROOM



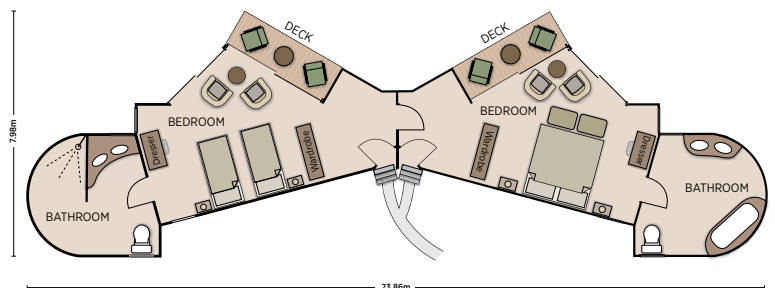
ROOM FACILITIES

PRIVATE VERANDA	Each chalet has its own private deck.
EN-SUITE BATHROOM	CHALET: shower, hand basin and toilet.
	FAMILY ROOM: large bathroom with shower, bath tub, vanity and toilet.
FANS & AIR-CONDITIONING	All rooms are air-conditioned and have fans.
POWER	220V multi adaptor plugs for charging photographic equipment.
SAFE	The safe is a lockable steel cabinet with its own key.
UMBRELLA	In case of rain.
AIR HORN	For use in case of an emergency.
HAIRDRYER	A small hairdryer is available in each room.
BATHROOM AMENITIES	A range of bathroom amenities including biodegradable soaps, shower gels etc.

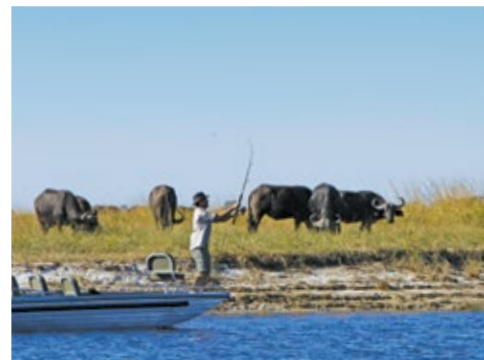

	MOTORISED BOAT SAFARIS	River excursions in small, easily maneuverable boats are ideal for close encounters with the wild visitors to the river's edge, in hard-bottom aluminum boats. The boats are equipped with comfortable seats, a foldaway canvas roof and life jackets.
	SKIMMER BRUNCH CRUISE	Guests can enjoy a relaxing brunch cruise on the skimmer boat for a chance to dine on the Chobe River while taking in the beautiful surroundings and exceptional wildlife.
	FISHING	Fishing is also a popular pastime; our catch-and-release fishing trips for Bream or Tiger fish (seasonal).

ACCESS TO CHOBE SAVANNA LODGE

Chobe Savanna Lodge is accessed via Kasane in Botswana by boat transfer. Upon arrival at the Kasane Airport from either international or scheduled flight, there is a road transfer (arranged by Desert & Delta Safaris) from the airport to Kasane Immigration jetty (approximately 10 minutes). After being met by your Chobe Savanna Lodge guide and Immigration procedures are complete, it is approximately 1 hour transfer by motorized boat up the Chobe River. The transfer includes a short stop at the Namibian immigration office for passport procedures.

Guests arriving from Victoria Falls/Livingstone should be transferred directly to the Kasane Immigration jetty in town.

SELF-DRIVE GUESTS

As the lodge is only accessible by boat guests should make their own arrangements to get to the Kasane Immigration jetty. There are no parking facilities at immigration but please contact us for further information pertaining to vehicles.

Clients connecting to Chobe Savanna Lodge on a Desert & Delta Safaris circuit will fly to or from Kasane airport. Remember the additional transfer time from Kasane Airport to Chobe Savanna Lodge via Kasane Immigration - allow for approximately 1.5 hours total transfer time from Kasane Airport.

PLEASE NOTE: Drone use is strictly prohibited at Chobe Savanna Lodge due to the sensitive environment in which the lodge operates.
