
ELEPHANT VALLEY LODGE

Elephant Valley Lodge lies between the Chobe National Park in Botswana and the equally impressive Matetsi wildlife conservancy, south of the Kazangula border crossing and within the Kasane Forest Reserve.

The camp comprises 20 'meru' style safari tents and can accommodate a maximum of 40 guests. The lodge overlooks an extremely active water hole. Activities include daily safaris and boat cruises into the Chobe National Park.

The unique lodge location provides guests with game viewing opportunities throughout the day and night.
