LOCATION

Sabi Sabi Private Game Reserve is an unspoilt part of Africa, ecologically and geographically integrated with the Greater Kruger National Park. It is situated within one of the oldest and largest proclaimed private reserves in Africa - the world renowned Sabie Game Reserve.

All the Sabi Sabi lodges are unfenced and with no fences between Sabi Sabi and the other reserves in the area, wildlife roams freely, giving guests the ultimate safari experience.

Sabi Sabi lies 500 km east of Johannesburg, 800 km north east of Durban and 200 km west of Maputo in Mozambique. It lies on the same latitude as Sao Paulo and Brisbane and the same longitude as Cairo, Istanbul and St. Petersburg.

SAFARIS

Sabi Sabi is renowned for its unforgettable safari experience. Home to the Big 5, as well as Cheetah, Wild Dog and hundreds of species of animals, birds, insects, reptiles and plants (including rare and endangered species), we offer close encounters with the wildlife.

All safaris are conducted in open vehicles, under the supervision of our highly skilled and trained field guides and Shangaan trackers. There are two safaris daily – each lasting approximately three hours – centred on prime viewing times (early morning and late afternoon/evening).

For an alternative exciting adventure guests can opt for a mid-morning environmental walking safari which reveals a totally different perspective of the bush. The walk, accompanied by an armed ranger, is approximately two hours long.

HOW TO GET THERE BY AIR:

- a. Daily shuttle flights from O.R. Tambo International Airport (Johannesburg) directly to the Sabi Sabi airstrip.
- b. Daily scheduled flights with Airlink, from O.R. Tambo International Airport (Johannesburg) and Cape Town International to Skukuza Airport.
- c. Daily scheduled flights from O.R. Tambo International Airport (Johannesburg) to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (Nelspruit) on Airlink, with a short air hop to the Sabi Sabi airstrip.
- d. Daily scheduled flights from Durban and Cape Town to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (Nelspruit) on Airlink with a short air hop to the Sabi Sabi airstrip.
- e. Private air charters on request.
- f. Helicopter transfers on request.

There are complimentary transfers between the Sabi Sabi airstrip and Sabi Sabi Lodges.

Car:

- 500 km from Johannesburg, an easy five-hour scenic drive on National Roads.
- Sabi Sabi is a two-hour scenic drive from Nelspruit. Road transfers can be arranged by Sabi Sabi from the Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport.
- Transfers can be arranged from Skukuza Airport to/from Sabi Sabi at an additional charge.

*The daily Sabie Game Reserve (SGR) Conservation Levy includes entry into the Reserve.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Dress completely informal. Neutral colours recommended.
(A full range of safari clothing is available from our Boutique Shops).
- Windbreaker or warm jacket for winter and night safaris.
- Comfortable walking shoes.
- Swimming costume - each lodge has a cool filtered pool.
- Binoculars, camera, video camera (don't forget extra film or camera tapes).
- Sunglasses, sunhats and sunblock.
- Please note that Sabi Sabi is situated within a malarial area. It is recommended that guests consult their physician or travel clinic regarding the latest, easily administered malaria prophylaxis.

SUITES AT SABI SABI

All suites at Sabi Sabi are equipped with:

All lodges have Internet access for guests wishing to stay in contact electronically. Power sources are (220v) and international adapters are available. Dietary requirements can be accommodated, subject to prior notification. Tap water is perfectly safe to drink, and bottled water is also provided in each suite.

TEMPERATURES AND SEASONS

Any time of year is a good time to visit Sabi Sabi, as each season in the bushveld has its own wonders. Spring and summer are our rainy seasons, which in turn makes the bush green, lush and thick. It is also the time of year where there are many newborn animals. Temperatures range from:

Spring (September to November)

Average Minimum 20 degrees Celsius (68 degrees Fahrenheit)

Average Maximum 31 degrees Celsius (88 degrees Fahrenheit)

Summer (December to February)

Average Minimum 22 degrees Celsius (72 degrees Fahrenheit)

Average Maximum 35 degrees Celsius (95 degrees Fahrenheit)

Autumn and winter are the dry months, the bush is less dense and with a lack of rain, animals frequent the waterholes more often. Temperatures range from:

Autumn (March to May)

Average Minimum 19 degrees Celsius (66 degrees Fahrenheit)

Average Maximum 28 degrees Celsius (82 degrees Fahrenheit)

Winter (June to August)

Average Minimum 12 degrees Celsius (54 degrees Fahrenheit)

Average Maximum 25 degrees Celsius (77 degrees Fahrenheit)
