


Kanana Okavango Delta Private Concession

You may actually enjoy the breath-taking spectacle of the water visibly rising around the camp's raised teak decks.

The Sleep Out Deck offers guests the opportunity to spend the night out under the magnificent African night sky.






Kanana Accommodation

Kanana was refurbished at the beginning of 2019. Guests are accommodated in seven spacious twin and double-bedded safari tents, each ensuite bathroom has a large walk-in shower and luxurious fittings. Families are accommodated in a two-bedroomed tent, sharing an en-suite bathroom with the addition of an outdoor shower – ideal for families in this child-friendly camp. The tents are well spaced, affording privacy whilst remaining within a comfortable distance from the main camp area.

There is the choice of either a double or twin bed configuration on comfortable three-quarter, extra length or king-sized beds. Every possible comfort has been catered for – from full solar electricity, standing and ceiling fans through to yoga mats and hair dryers!

Families are accommodated in a custom build two bedroom shared ensuite bathroom family tent sleeping a maximum of 5 people.




Kanana Activities

Courtesy of its location Kanana can offer both water and land activities year-round. Motorboats or Mokoro provide a chance to experience the incredible bird, plant and reptile species found in the aquatic habitat of the Okavango Delta. Game drives are conducted by a personal guide in comfortable, specially designed game drive vehicles. When out on game drives our window seat guarantee ensures no more than four guests per vehicle and individual use of a camera mount. For the more adventurous, guided walks are also available while fishing enthusiasts will enjoy fishing for a variety of species such as tilapia and tigerfish.

Kanana is situated on a private concession which allows guided walks, Mokoro excursions and night drives in addition to game drives and motorboat trips. Kanana's excellent location in the Okavango Delta ensures a combination of permanent water access for year-round water activities and large dry areas for game drive routes. This blend of environments provides the habitat for a consistently wide variety of wildlife, including the elusive sitatunga antelope and a healthy population of leopards.

Fishing is available throughout the year (with exception of January and February), with excellent bream fishing from May to September and superb chances of landing tigerfish during September to mid-November.





Kanana Heronry

- Located within the Kanana private concession, camp guests are afforded an exclusive experience.
- The largest and most active heronry in Southern Africa.
- Guests may accessible the area via boat or mokoro all year round. Even in low water level seasons.
- Pel's Fishing Owl have breeding sights on Islands accessible by boat, Mokoro or vehicle.
- The area vegetation consists predominantly of Waterberry trees and Gomoti water fig.





Pink Backed Pelicans

• All the normal Delta bird species are represented, and, from July through October, the heronry plays host to Pink Backed Pelicans, Reed Cormorants, three types of Herons (Grey, Black Crowed Night & Green Backed), Darters, three types of Egrets, Marabou Storks and both Glossy and Sacred Ibis.

• Approximately 100 hectares in extent and the most important Southern African breeding site for Pink Backed Pelicans.



- The Sleep Out Deck offers guests a panoramic view and the opportunity to spend the night under the magnificent African night sky
- Requires advanced booking.
- Available to guests staying three or more nights at Kanana.
- Bathroom facilities consist of a toilet and wash basin.
- Your tent will be kept for you back at camp.
- Your guide, contactable by two way radio, will be accommodated a comfortable distance away.

Vehicle Policy – Window Seat Guarantee

- Toyota Land Cruisers customized into Game Viewers.
- Maximum 4 people per vehicle.
- Guaranteed window seat for all guests.
- Camera Mount for each window seat padded armrest that moves up and down.
- 2 rows 3 seats per row.
- Removable roof and folded down windscreen.
- Curtesy lights and easy access steps.
- Compartment for each row to store camera equipment, binoculars and personal items.
- Also on the vehicle bean bags, wet-wipes, hand sanitizer, tissues, toilet paper, paper bags and mints.
- Cooler box with refreshments and glass water bottles.
- Tea box for morning activities and sundowner snack for afternoon activities.
- Private vehicle available on request ahead of travel.
