Olkeri is the Maasai epithet for the leopard, the spotted ambush hunter, one of the most emblematic inhabitants of the area. Home to great Elephant herds, this beautiful tract of wilderness, replete with views of woodlands, rocky hills and shaded by gnarled oldgrowth Baobab and Acacia, offers the ultimate freedom to explore day and night.
