Simbavati Grumeti is nestled on the open plains between the Serengeti National Park and the Grumeti River, within Tanzania's fabled northern safari circuit. It is on these acacia dotted plains that multitudes of wildlife congregate all year round in a game viewing spectacular.

These plains also play host to vast herds of wildebeest, which assemble during their annual migration and move between the north and south of the Serengeti National Park. You may also be lucky enough to see buffalo, giraffe, lion and other wildlife from your tent and the lodge.

WHY VISIT?

The Greater Serengeti National Park Ecosystem

Simbavati Grumeti is located in the Ikona Wildlife Management Area (WMA), nestled between the Serengeti National Park and the Grumeti River. Ikona WMA was established in 2003 to spread economic benefit derived from tourism to the 5 villages that form part of this community, and to create a buffer zone for the protection of the national park.

This area supports a variety of wildlife across 242 square kilometers of pristine wilderness including herds of elephant, waterbuck, Black and White colobus monkeys and shy leopard. Ikona WMA is the assembly point of the wildebeest during their annual migration when the vast herds move in the direction of the northern Serengeti for the famous Grumeti River crossings. A major advantage to this area, is spectacular night game drives, as well as walking safaris that are offered.

- Dinner on the deck, or around the fire in the open air boma (weather permitting)






Lodge Layout

GETTING THERE

Travel Options

Fly to Fort Ikoma airstrip. Upon arrival, a short transfer will transport you to the lodge (approximately 20-minutes long).

Fly to Seronera airstrip. Upon arrival guests will enjoy a game drive in Serengeti National Park while on transfer to the lodge (approximately 2-hours long with Serengeti National Park fees payable). Drive from Arusha (approximately 355 kilometers) to Simbavati Grumeti.
