

Simbavati Hilltop Lodge has a light footprint, purposely designed so that it can be removed without leaving any lasting impact on the land. It's perched on a hilltop in Timbavati Private Game Reserve, in the Greater Kruger National Park – with wide angle views over the bush and views to the distant mountains of the Drakensberg escarpment.

Below lie the expansive Mbali Dam and the Nhlaralumi River, where you may be lucky to see elephant, and other wildlife, come to quench their thirst.



## Timbavati



The Timbavati Private Game Reserve borders the Kruger National Park to the north and east. The name Timbavati was derived from a Shangaan expression meaning 'the place where something sacred came down to earth from the heavens'.

The Timbavati has a vast array of wildlife, which includes the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino) thriving amongst giraffe, zebra, warthogs, hyena and many antelope species. This sums up the magical spirit of the Timbavati, which has a tangible sense of wilderness.

The reserve is also a protective habitat for sustainable populations of many endangered species such as black and white rhinoceros, pangolins, and many others.

• King beds (convertible to twin) • En suite bathroom tent connected to main tent via a small passage which also provides access to an outdoor twin rain shower • Ample storage space • Expansive viewing deck • Private sala pavilion with double day bed • Views over the bushveld, dam and Nhlaralumi River

**Note:** Not suitable for people who have difficulty walking, as each tent is accessed by a number of steps. However, two tents are considerably closer, and have fewer steps but it is steeper! Please make mention of any issues relating to guests' mobility at the time of booking.
