

SOVEREIGN HOUSEBOAT, LAKE KARIBA – FACT SHEET

LOCATION:

Embarking from Masumu River Lodge in Binga to sail on Lake Kariba, the Sovereign Houseboat offers a unique safari experience. Designed with space and style in mind, the experience ensures options for relaxation throughout your stay, fringed in luxury. Lake Kariba is the world's largest man-made lake, located along the border between Zimbabwe and Zambia.

CLIMATE:

Summer months (September to March) tend to be quite hot and have the highest rainfall of the year.

Cooler months (April to August) tend to have cool to warm days, with evening and night temperatures being rather chilly.

ACCOMMODATION:

10 en-suite air-conditioned rooms each with a view of the lake.

THE MAIN AREA:

The Sovereign Houseboat was designed with space and style in mind, ensuring options for relaxation throughout your stay, fringed in luxury. The lounge and 10 bedrooms are air conditioned, allowing for a moment of cool and quiet from the African heat. Panoramic views lure guests to the lounge area, as well as up a staircase leading to a daybed which boasts a bird's eye view of the lake and its surrounds. A swimming pool calls for relaxation and reprieve, as well as offering the perfect spot for a gin and tonic, paired best with sunset.

FOOD:

A wide variety of cuisine is offered with a Zimbabwean theme.

All guest amenities include shampoo, conditioner, liquid shower gel and soaps.

WATER SUPPLY:



Water is supplied from the lake for showering. Drinking water is processed through reverse osmosis and is safe for drinking.

ACTIVITIES:

Sunrise and Sunset Game Viewing Cruises:

Rise with the sun or bid farewell to the day by embarking on a cruise on Lake Kariba waters on our tender boats. Both times of day hold equal potential for game viewing, the morning boasting an array of birdlife and the evening luring wildlife down for a sunset drink.

Fishing:

Armed with patience, focus and a fishing rod, drop a line in the water on a fishing expedition on one of our smaller tender boats. Head out with the captain, find a quiet spot tied to a tree, sipping on a coffee or a gin and tonic and fish for your lunch!

A Lake Kariba beach barbeque experience awaits, set up on one of the remote islands scattered around. Sink your feet into fine white Kariba beach sand, cocktail in hand, bidding the day farewell from shore. With a campfire and barbeque as your backdrop, life simply cannot get better.
